Introduction

Have you ever heard of Trash? It's a card game that has luck AND strategy! Have you ever thought about playing it? Well, don't be deceived by Trash's name, it's actually an awesome card game!

Chapter 1

Setting up

When you play Trash, you need a 52-card deck with the back showing, 2 to 6 players, and playing space. Put a draw pile in the middle of your playing space and a discard pile next to it. Each player grabs 10 cards from the deck and puts them in order in front of themselves. They can put their cards in a pyramid, 5 on top and 5 on the bottom, or just a straight line. The card to the left, or at the top is the ace. The card next to the ace is the 2. And so on and so on. The players must remember not to look at the cards until they start their turn. Look onto the next page to learn what you do when it is your turn.

Chapter 2

On Your Turn

When it is your turn, grab a card from the draw pile and see what it says. For example, say you had a 7. Put your card on the 7th card in front of you. Pick up the card that used to be on the 7th spot and see what it says. It is an ace. So put that card at the ace's spot and pick up the card that used to be there. It is a jack. Queens and jacks mean nothing, so you must put that card on the discard pile and end your turn. Then the next person goes. Let us say that on your 2nd turn you get a king. Kings are wild cards, so you can put them anywhere. Are you wondering how to win? Is there anything else you want to know about Trash? Look onto the next paragraph to learn about the object of the game and rounds.

Chapter 3

The object of the Game and Rounds

The object of the game is to have all 10 cards showing before the other player. Usually, a game of Trash would last around 5 minutes. That's short. So, Trash has multiple rounds. In the next round, whoever won the round before that gets 1 less card. Then whoever wins that round also gets to have 1 less card. This keeps going until a player wins a round when they have only 1 card left. Getting the right card when you only have 1 card left is the most exciting round of Trash.
